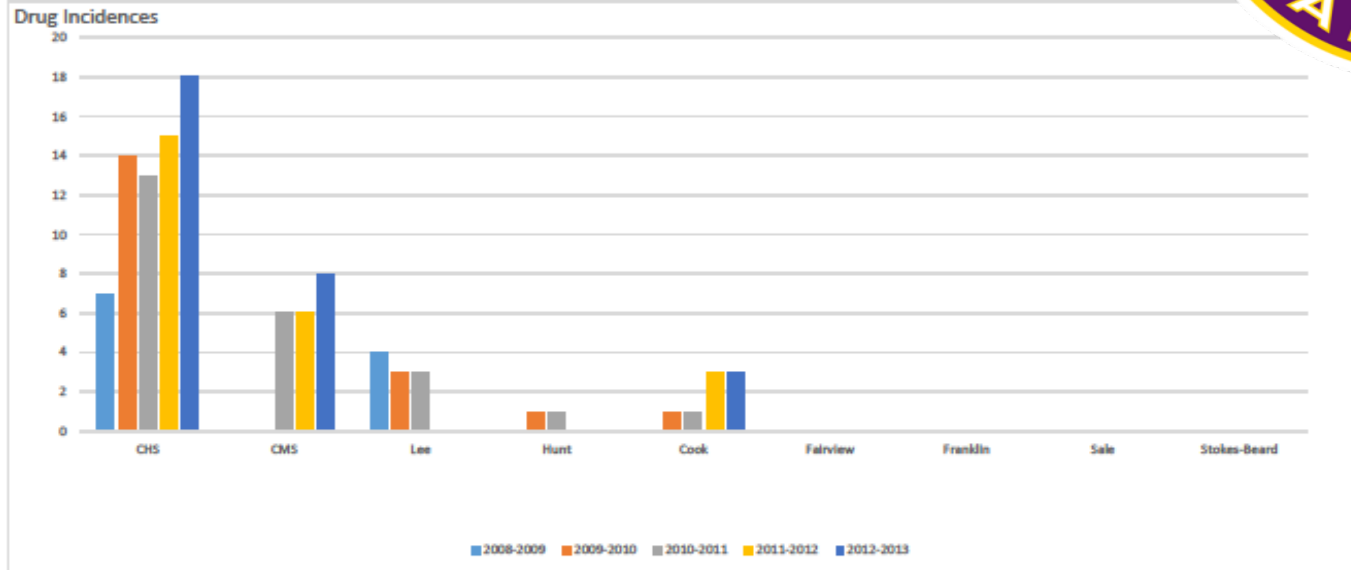

**Notes:**

- CMS opened and Lee Middle School and Hunt Intermediate closed mid year 2010-2011.
- All drug reported incidences have involved Marijuana except 1 incidence at CHS in 2012-2013 which involved prescription drugs.



## Implications:

- The incidence of reported cases of drug abuse (district-wide) has increased from 11 in 2008-2009 to 29 in 2012-2013.
  - The incidence of drug abuse at CHS has increased from 7 in 2008-2009 to 18 in 2012-2013.
  - As of December, 2013, 16 instances of drug abuse (<1%) have been reported.
  - More students are abusing drugs, and/or

- Staff Training and SRO's have resulted in increased identification of drug abuse.



## Recommendations:

- Continue training and implementation of Positive Behavior Intervention Support
  - Utilize drug dogs to spot check for drug abuse
  - Consider the implementation of a random drug testing program
  - Provide staff training for increased prevention and identification of drug abuse.
