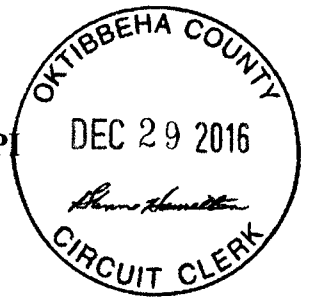

BILL OF EXCEPTIONS


