**PETITION TO REVOKE SUSPENSION OF SENTENCE**

Comes now the State of Mississippi and files this Petition to Revoke Suspension of Sentence against the Defendant, John A. Redden, herein, and with respect would show unto the Court the following facts, to-wit:

That the Defendant was at the February 2013 Term of Circuit Court in Lowndes County, Mississippi, after pleading guilty to the charge of Aggravated Assault-Domestic Violence, and was then and there sentenced to serve a term of FIVE (5) years in the custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections with that sentence suspended for a period of FIVE (5) years. That since having his sentence suspended, the Defendant has violated the terms of his suspended sentence in that he:

**A. Defendant was charged with the offenses of Simple Assault and Misdemeanor Malicious Mischief by the Lowndes County Sheriff's Department on July 3, 2013.**

Due to his previous record and continuous violation of the conditions of his suspended sentence should now be revoked and that he should be required to serve five years in the Mississippi Department of Corrections, as such sentence was originally imposed by the Court.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, your petitioner prays the Court to fix a date, time, and place to hear this petition and the Clerk of this Court issue an alias warrant directed to the Sheriff, or any other lawful officer of said County, for the immediate arrest of said Defendant, and

that process issue to the Defendant commanding him be at such place on said date and time fixed by the Court to show cause, if any he can, why the suspended sentence previously granted to him should not be revoked and why he should not now be required to serve five years in the Mississippi Department of Corrections as such sentence was originally imposed by the Court, or for such other period of time as to the Court may seem meet and proper in the premises.
