I, Officer Carpenter, responded to a call at Brewski's about a possible intoxicated driver or a medical emergency. As I was traveling north on Louisville Street I saw a vehicle matching the description given by the caller and I turned around to verify the tag. I saw that it was the same vehicle we were looking for and I noticed that the vehicle had drifted onto the center line as it was traveling east on Yellow Jacket. I stopped the vehicle and approached the driver. I recognized the driver as Mrs. Chief Lindley and I was quite clear that she was intoxicated. The vehicle smelled of intoxicating beverage and I could tell that her speech was extremely slurred. I spoke with Mrs. Chief Lindley and asked her if she had been drinking. I figured I already knew the answer but she did say she had not had anything. I also noticed she had glassy red eyes when she spoke. Officer Jones offered her the PBT and she did register positive for alcohol.

I explained that I was going to take her to the station and offer her the test. Mrs. Chief Lindley said " It is what it is." I transported her to the station. At the station I had to steady her as she walked across the parking lot. It was pretty clear that field sobriety test were out of the question so I observed Mrs. Chief Lindley for twenty minutes. During this time she did not regurgitate or belch. After the twenty minute waiting period I read Mrs. Chief Lindley her right to refuse the test. She elected to take the test and registered .13. Mrs. Chief Lindley was read her right to make a telephone call for legal or medical assistance after being booked. Mrs. Chief Lindley was booked and posted bond with A Bail Bonding.
